National Trail Ride Application

Any Affiliate Chapter or for profit organization

interested in sponsoring a National Trail Ride must adhere to the following criteria.

All rides must be approved by the Chairperson of the Trail Ride Committee.

Criteria For National Trail Ride

There are three types of qualified rides at which a member can earn credit toward awards: 1) Rides sponsored by MFTHBA; 2) Rides sponsored or co-sponsored by an affiliate or co-sponsored with another affiliate; and 3) Rides sponsored by a for-profit organization.

1. The ride must be at least 2 days with a minimum of a 2 hour ride with a guide.
2. Each affiliate may sponsor two rides annually and co-share sponsorship of one additional ride with another affiliate.
3. Any number of rides may be held by a for-profit organization, if approved by the MFTHBA Trail committee.
4. A \$50 Trail Ride application fee is required for for-profit organizations/facilities.
5. The sponsoring organization, for-profit organization, or one of the co-sponsoring organizations must apply for approval of each ride. The application must be written and must be received by the MFTHBA office, not less than 45 days prior to the date of the ride. The application must furnish the following information:

A. Contact name, phone number and email address for sponsor or for-profit organization.

B. A description of facilities available for horses (corrals, stalls, highline, etc.)

C. Coggins, health papers and feed requirements for animals.

D. A description of facilities available (hook-ups, electric, water, primitive, cabins or other accommodations, etc.)

E. Eating services. Meal provided and which day, pot luck, restaurants, eat on your own etc.

An Affiliate staying at a non-profit facility is not required to provide a meal.

An Affiliate staying at a for-profit facility may provide one meal either on Friday or Saturday or may opt out.
Meal Provided Opt out

A For-Profit organization/facility must provide at least 1 meal with the ride either on Friday or Saturday.

F. Other information such as number of riders expected, type of trails, terrain etc.

G. If any part of the ride is on public land, has proper use permits been obtained? Yes No N/A

H. Charge for the ride, stalls, camper hook-ups.

5. A follow-up report must be submitted to the MFTHBA office. The follow-up report will contain: Total number riders, qualifying riders name, address and MFTHBA member number; horse registered name and MFTHBA registration number; problems and plans for the future. If the ride was sponsored by a for-profit organization, the follow-up report must be accompanied by payment of a **\$5.00 fee for all riders qualifying for MFTHBA awards program. Affiliate sponsored rides will be assessed the \$5.00 fee per rider qualifying for the MFTHBA awards program regardless of the organization facility.** The National Trail Rides during the MFTHBA Spring Show and Celebration are excluded from these fees. Riders will not be given credit towards awards until the follow-up report and accompanying fees are received by the MFTHBA Office.
