Crystal Lake Fisheries & Farm

This is Private Property. The farm is located seven miles east of Ava. This is a privately owned wilderness area with bubbling natural springs in every hollow. The trail consists of rocky footing with moderate hill climbs.

From the MFTHBA showgrounds: travel south on State Highway 5 through the signal light and to the south 4-way stop at the south junction of State Highway 5 and State Highway 76 (Approximately 3 miles). Turn left at the 4-way stop onto South Jefferson Street/Business 5 and continue to the Ava Square (approximately .7 miles). Turn right onto the Square, then a left on the square, then right onto State Highway 14. Travel east from Ava Square on State Highway 14 to State Highway V V. For approximately 4.5 miles. Turn left onto State Highway V V and travel to end of black top (3 miles). Turn left onto Douglas County Rd V V-210 and continue to stay left, travel on gravel approximately a mile. Look for the sign "MFTHBA Trail Head parking on your left.
