



Hall of Fame Award Nomination For Distinguished Service To The Missouri Fox Trotting Horse Breed Association

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Rules for the Hall of Fame Award

1. In recognition of devoted and invaluable service rendered to the MFTHBA, an annual Award is presented to a single individual or individuals for distinguished achievement in the MFTHBA.
2. The presentation of the Award will be made at the Annual Show & Celebration.
3. The Award shall consist of a plaque with an appropriate citation and the name of the recipient inscribed thereon. The recipient's name will be printed in the MFTHBA Annual Show & Celebration catalog.

Eligibility

4. The conditions of eligibility are as follows:
 - A. The nominee may be living or deceased. If living, nominee must be a current member or if deceased must have been a past member.
 - B. Nominee shall have been identified with the horse industry for a minimum of ten (10) years.
 - C. Nominee shall have contributed to the horse industry, in addition to nominee's own operation, something of value in the field of leadership and education that has proved of value and will continue to prove of value to the horse industry.
 - D. Nominee shall have been consistent in attending the activities of the MFTHBA.
 - E. Nominee shall have participated actively in the affairs of the annual meeting, shows and specific events.
 - F. Distinguished achievement may include significant contributions to the knowledge and literature of the horse industry, the design or invention of material, equipment, processes, or technical services; or outstanding service to the association, companies and other organizations serving the horse industry.

Nomination

- A. Nomination forms shall be available to all MFTHBA active members for purpose of nominating worthy candidates. These shall be available in The Journal and on-line. Along with the completed nomination form, nominators shall submit additional support documents which address worthiness of the candidate to receive the award.
Complete nomination forms along with supporting documents are due in the MFTHBA office by **June 15th each year**.
- C. The MFTHBA Board of Directors will consider the nominations and approve award recipients at their Board meeting, so that awards can be prepared for presentation at the September Show & Celebration.
- D. All collected materials become the property of the MFTHBA and will be held in the MFTHBA office for a minimum of 1 year.
