High Point Versatility Awards will be given in the following two divisions: Youth Versatility Champion and Open Versatility Champion

Out Of State: Rider must reside outside the state of Missouri, Horse must be owned by member residing outside of the state of Missouri.

All classes in the Main Arena are 2 gait (walk and foxtrot) unless otherwise specified.

TO ENTER A HORSE IN THE SHOW:

- 1. All horses entered in the show must be registered in the Missouri Fox Trotting Horse Breed Association or the Missouri Fox Trotting Pony Registry.
- 2. You must present current negative Coggins test papers with horse pass sticker and original registration certificate of registration or copy of front and back at entry desk.
- 3. A one time cattle fee of \$40 per participant will be assessed for Ranch Sorting. There will also be a \$10 per run fee per participant payable at the time of entry. Payment must be made by **CASH** and will be collected at the versatility arena the morning of the event starting at 8:00am. Payment must be made in order to participate in the Ranch Sorting Class or Jackpot Out of respect for those that paid for the sorting, other horses will not be allowed in the versatility arena during the Ranch Sorting Classor Jackpot.
- 4. The Board reserves the right to combine or split classes as needed. The Board of Directors, Show Committee and Office Staff are not responsible and reserve the right to correct typographical errors.

EXHIBITORS:

- 1. All exhibitors will be expected to comply with the Rules, Standards and Policies book of the Missouri Fox Trotting Horse Breed Association.
- 2. Any exhibitor causing undue disturbance or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be barred from showing in this show and will forfeit all winnings for this show.
- 3. Each exhibitor will be assessed a show entry fee.
- 4. It is recommended that all youth age 11 & under wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet and use an electronic wireless device while riding at any time on the MFTHBA grounds.
- 5. Youth 11 and under will be allowed to Exhibit only in designated youth classes.
- 6. JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

NOTICE: Anyone arriving earlier than the designated arrival date will be charged \$30 per day per camper and \$20 per day utility fee per horse on the grounds.

Novice: Exhibitors may not have won a Reserve World Championship, a Reserve World Grand Championship, or 1st place in any MFTHBA Performance class, excluding Novice/Apprentice and Youth divisions. Once an individual has won an Amateur Novice or Amateur Apprentice Division Championship they may no longer show in Amateur Apprentice classes. Youth who have exhibited and won in Non-Youth performance classes may not show in this division.

<u>Limited Rider</u>: Exhibitors may not have won a Performance WGC or Reserve WGC at **any time**, excluding Novice and Youth divisions. Exhibitors may not have won a 1st or 2nd place in any MFTHBA performance class, excluding Novice/Apprentice and Youth, in the last two calendar years. Youth who have won Non-Youth performance WGC, Res WGC, or 1st/2nd place, may not show in this division.

AMATEUR OWNED NO PROFESSIONALTRAINING 90 DAYS:

This division must meet all requirements for the Amateur Owned division. Horses entered into this class may not receive professional training 90 days prior to the show.

OPEN AMATEUR: Open Amateur classes are open to any Amateur Rider. There are no restrictions on ownership of the horse except that the horse's owner must be a current MFTHBA member. Exhibitors must be current MFTHBA members, must hold a current Amateur Card. Entered horses must meet the age and gender requirements of the class and be registered with the MFTHBA.

- *All Classes in the Main Arena are two gait (walk and foxtrot) unless otherwise specified*
- *Youth 11 and under will be allowed to Exhibit only in designated youth classes. All youth age 6 & under will be required to have an attendant in the arena while exhibiting in a class.

It is recommended that all youth age 11 & under wear an ASTM/SEI certified belief

- ***Classes designated as either Ladies or Men's classes are 18 years and over***
- *** Out of State classes are both horse (recorded owner) & exhibitor must live outside the state of Missouri***

The Show Office will be closed from 12pm to 1pm each day except for Saturday.

NOTICE **Anyone arriving earlier than the designated arrival date will be charged \$30 per day per camper and \$20 per day utility fee per horse on the grounds.**

TO ENTER THE HORSE IN THE SHOW:

- 1. ALL horses entered in the show must be registered in the Missouri Fox Trotting Horse Breed Assoc. or Missouri Fox Trotting Pony Registry 2. You must present current negative Coggins papers with the horse pass sticker and original registration papers (or a copy of front & back) at entry desk when entering for classes
- 3. ALL horses entering the show grounds MUST have a Health certificate done within 30 days AND a current negative Coggins (EIA) test These papers must be presented at the show grounds gate. (The Board recommends that all horses be vaccinated for influenza.)
- 4. The owner of the horse must be a current MFTHBA member.

EXHIBITORS: EXHIBITORS:

- 1. All exhibitors must be a current member of the MFTHBA with the exception of Lead Line riders.
- 2. Exhibitors must have either an amateur card or a professional card unless entering an undesignated class.
- 3. Exhibitors are responsible for entering the correct class and knowing the requirements to enter.
- 4. All exhibitors will be expected to comply with the Rules, Standards & Policies book of the MFTHBA. Any exhibitor causing undue disturbance or exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be barred from showing in this show and will forfeit all winnings for this show. Each exhibitor will be assessed a show entry fee with the exception of youth classes.

Note

Versatility Classes MUST be entered the day before the show. No exceptions. Evening performance & model class entries will close at 4:30 pm and Saturday entries will close at 2:00pm. No exceptions. The Board reserves the right to combine or split classes and to revise the class schedule as needed.

** A one time cattle fee of \$40 will be charged for the Friday and Saturday Ranch Sorting Classes & Jackpot per exhibitor and an additional fee of \$10 per run per exhibitor will be assessed. Payment must be made by cash, and will be collected at the versatility arena the morning of the event starting at 8:00am. Payment must be made in order to participate in the Ranch Sorting Class or Jackpot. Out of respect for those that paid for the sorting, other horses will not be allowed in the versatility arena during the Ranch Sorting Class or Jackpot**
