### MFTHBYA PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

The purpose of the Missouri Fox Trotters Horse Breed Youth Association (MFTHBYA) Participation Program is to encourage and reward youth members for involvement in equine activities with and about Missouri Fox Trotters, regardless of geographical location or chosen discipline. The Youth Advisory Committee believes the youth are the future of our breed. This program is designed to promote our future, today.

The MFTHBYA participation program is a point-based program available to all MFTHBYA members. End of the year awards will be presented to members based on total points accrued. Additionally, for a one-time fee of \$25, members can register for a MFTHBYA scholarship fund. This fund will be maintained and administered by the MFTHBA. The funds will be added to the Youth member's account at the end of each year, based on the number of points earned. (SEE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ATTACHMENT FOR FULL DETAILS).

Points will be awarded for activities related to riding and promoting Missouri Fox Trotters. Examples of activities: national trail rides, national horse shows, other organized trail rides, fun shows, open gaited breed shows, newsletter article or photo submissions, attend/work at promotional events, MFTHBYA Delegate program participation, MFTHBA Partner events.

### **PARTICIPATION RULES**

- 1. Participants must be current MFTHBYA members.
- 2. Points will be awarded only for activities reported after annual membership and program participation registration have been received by the MFTHBA office. The date of receipt will be determined by received stamp applied by the MFTHBA office.
- 3. Registration for the next calendar year will open on December 1 of the current year. Example: Registration for January 1, 2022 will open on December 1, 2021.
- 4. For points to be awarded, a completed Activity Report must be submitted to the MFTHBA office. Activity Reports must be signed by an event organizer. Immediate family member signatures will not be accepted.
- 5. Activities including a horse (shows, trail rides, parades, drill teams, etc) must be completed with a registered Missouri Fox Trotter. The horse's name and registration number will be required on the Activity Report.

### YEAR END AWARDS

The MFTHBYA Participation Program will run January 1 – December 31, annually. High point honors will be awarded to the top 5 participants in each MFTHBA Region. Overall high point awards will be presented to the top 5 participants. Specific awards will be chosen by the Youth Board and the Youth Advisory Committee.

### SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- 1. The MFTHBYA Participation program scholarship awards will be open to all MFTHBYA members.
- 2. A \$25 one time set up fee will be paid to the MFTHBA with initial application to the scholarship fund.
- 3. Members must maintain MFTHBYA/MFTHBA membership annually to continue to participate in the program.
- 4. The MFTHBYA Participation Program Scholarship funds will be held and managed by the MFTHBA.
- 5. Any participant whose membership lapses for one full year will forfeit all monies earned. If the member renews membership after one year, they may re-apply and participate in the program, but previously awarded funds will not be available.
- 6. Annual statements will be provided to each participant.
- 7. Scholarship funds may be used for Junior College, University, or Vocational Education programs.
- 8. Scholarship payments may be used in 1 4 installments.
- 9. Initial withdrawal must be initiated by January 1 of the year following the participant's 24<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- 10. Funds not dispersed by August 31 of the year following the participant's 26<sup>th</sup> birthday will be forfeited.
- 11. Any participant funds forfeited will be returned to the MFTHBYA account.
